



The National FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit Program

The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) program is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program to help households struggling to pay for internet service during the pandemic. The EBB will provide a discount up to \$50.00 per month towards broadband service for eligible households.

The benefit is limited to one monthly discount per household. The Emergency Broadband Benefit is temporary and will conclude when the fund is expended or six months after the end of the public health emergency.

Chocolate Covered Halloween Pretzels

Ingredients

- **1 Cup** White Chocolate Chips
- **1 Cup** Chocolate Chips
- **1 Bag** Pretzel Rods

Decorating Ideas

- Sprinkles — Orange, Purple, Green, or Black
- Candy Eyes
- Candy Corn
- Green and Orange Candy melts

Instructions

- 1) Line a pan with parchment paper.
- 2) Melt the white chocolate chips and chocolate chips in 30 second intervals in a tall bowl/mug, stirring after each, until the chocolate is smooth.
- 3) Take one pretzel rod and dip it into the chocolate. Use a spoon to add additional chocolate to the pretzel stick to coat it about half way.
- 4) Top pretzels with sprinkles, candy eyes, candy corn, or drizzle with orange or green candy melts.
- 5) Allow to set and enjoy.
